





HKUST Business School offers access to the following international programs:

Yale Master of Advanced Management (Yale MAM)

MBA students have the opportunity to enroll in the Yale MAM program offered by the School of Management at Yale University and receive a concurrent degree.

Global Network for Advanced Management (GNAM)

- Global Network Week (GN Week) is an one-week intensive elective which will be offered physical or online mode, subject to the organizer.
- Credit-bearing Small Network Online Courses (SNOCs) are offered virtually by member schools. These courses connect students online in lectures, discussions or collaborative team projects.

Admissions Requirements

To apply for our Part-time MBA (Weekly Mode) program, you will need the following:

- Bachelor's degree
- Minimum of 3 years of full-time work experience

- Satisfactory GMAT/GRE score*
- Ability and commitment to contribute to the MBA community

Our program is taught in English. If English was not the language of instruction used at your undergraduate or postgraduate degree-granting institute, you must provide a satisfactory TOEFL or IELTS score.

*Applicants with more than 7 years' full-time work experience are eligible to apply for a GMAT waiver, which is subject to approval.

Scholarships and Financial Aid

Terry Tsang MBA Admissions Scholarship

The scholarship, awarded by the honorable HKUST MBA alumnus, is offered to admitted candidates who demonstrate strengths in their background, exposure and admissions performance. Preference will be given to graduates of HKUST undergraduate and postgraduate degree programs.

Continuing Education Fund

Hong Kong residents may apply for a study loan through the Government Student Financial Assistance Agency.

Our program is listed under the Continuing Education Fund (CEF) scheme which provides reimbursement of up to HKD25,000. Details are available at www.wfsfaa.gov.hk.

HKUST MBA Community Succession Scheme (CSS)

If you are a returning HKUST degree program graduate or are referred by an HKUST MBA or EMBA alumnus, you can enjoy an application fee waiver, guaranteed admissions interview and tuition fee allowance upon successful admission.

Company Nomination Scheme (CNS)

Candidates who present a valid recommendation letter from the human resources department of any CNS participating company may enjoy an allowance of HKD45,000, which will be deducted from the tuition for the 2023/2024 academic year upon successful admission.
